GENERAL NOTES

The therapist has noted some aphasia d/t TBI sustained in a motorcycle accident in 2002. This should be accounted for in the Neuro/Emotional/Behavioral section of the OASIS and under the Functional Limitations section as well.

The previous use of code S06.360A is invalid because this is a resolved injury. The TBI occurred in 2002. Dx codes for residual deficits d/t this TBI have been provided.

Improve Accuracy - Proposed changes to OASIS answers are based on available documentation, clinical judgement, and current CMS guidelines.

OASIS RECOMMENDATIONS

- M1342 ORIGINAL RESPONSE: 2
HHA RECOMMENDATION: 0
Explanation: Surgical wounds healing by primary intention do not granulate, therefore the only appropriate responses would be 0 or 3. If there is not full epithelial resurfacing such as a scab adhering to underlying tissue or either active drainage or serious drainage, then the correct answer is 3-Not healing. Based on the wound description, the recommended response is 0-newly epithelialized.
- M1720 ORIGINAL RESPONSE: 0
HHA RECOMMENDATION: 1
Explanation: Given the recent hospitalization, rehab stay with treatment changes, and active meds, it is likely that this patient has occasional anxiety.
- M1740 ORIGINAL RESPONSE: 7
HHA RECOMMENDATION: 1
Explanation: There is documentation of memory concerns that should be accounted for here.

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
